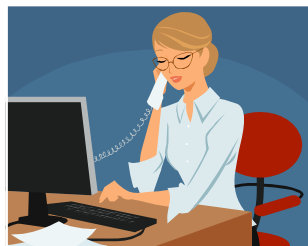

Community Advocates for Family & Youth

Victims Journey



Case Manager

- Mails out your Victims' Rights Packet
- Calls you to introduce CAFY
- Takes Intake Call
- Assesses your High Level Needs
- **Assigns an Advocate to your case**



CAFY Advocate

- Calls you to begin on-going support based on your needs
- Provides on-going support through the range of services CAFY offers

Case Management

Your advocate reviews Victims' Rights Info Packet with you

Helps you to complete the Criminal Injury Compensation Board (CICB)

Discusses CAFY Services with you to determine what solutions suit your needs

Helps you to complete the Victim Information Notification Everyday (VINE)

Trauma Support Your advocate discusses the different referral solutions available

Provides Support and Encouragement *'We are here for you'*



Bilingual Interpreter available as needed

Court Education

You are scheduled for Court Education Program (CEP)

You receive confirmation of class approx 7 days prior to date

You get a reminder phone call 2 days prior to class

You attend CEP

Your advocate prepares you to manage anxiety as a result of victimization *Discusses TAVA as appropriate*

Prepares you to be an effective witness during a mock trial *Judge and Asst. State Attorney are present*



Bilingual Interpreter available as needed

Court Companionship

An advocate provides morale support in court proceedings to you and your children



Support Group

CAFY Support Group Survivors are Free and Empowered (SAFE) *Children over 12, Adults & Family*

You attend a 6-week LIFE module session focused on Healing

Topics covered over 6 Weeks
• Road to Healing
• Facing Anger, Shame and Hurt
• Trusting Yourself
• Who Loves YOU
• Daily Self Care
• Moving on and Taking Back
